

**List of Fish found in the Freshwaters of Nova Scotia
A review of Common Names and the taxonomy applied
to these species**

*with synonyms used in the literature relating to Nova Scotia,
including Mi'kmaw names for fish*

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Introduction

The Fishes of Nova Scotia have been documented both in the scientific and popular literature for approximately 400 years. As with other taxonomic groups, there have been some changes in nomenclature, including some relating to the establishment of a formal taxonomic structure in the mid-18th century in addition. Other changes have been made to reflect more-contemporary reviews of systematic relationships.

Due to their popularity of this group of animals in both in the naturalist as well as the recreational fishing communities, there has been a considerably greater degree of assignation of names to fish, perhaps without the rigour applied to other groups.

This report includes anadromous and catadromous species as well as seasonally or occasionally transient species from brackish waters. Of the 58 species of fish noted in this document, most have undergone some form of nominal revision. This document summarizes names (both scientific and common) for these species, including those, which are in a strict sense, true synonyms as well as those, which may have been used commonly or possibly erroneously in the past. In many cases in the early literature, names of similar European species had been applied to this fauna in the as a matter of course.

This review also includes a number of names that reflect orthographic errors in their publication. In this way, this report can be used as a reference to clarify which species were, in fact, being discussed in these earlier works.

This document has been created in part to assist in the review of older and perhaps more-obscure popular and scientific literature regarding this element of Nova Scotia's fauna (both past and present). As such, it is also to a degree a bibliography to the Freshwater Fish of Nova Scotia.

References have been included for New Brunswick, Prince Edward Island, insular Newfoundland as well as the New England states due to the common history of ichthyological work undertaken in the past in the region.

The names are provided in the following format:

Genus (name and authority and synonymous names used in these articles)

Species (name and authority - based on the Integrated Taxonomic Information System (ITIS) accessed 3 October 2018)

Within each species, the following are provided, if available:

synonymous specific and sub-specific names

common English names (currently accepted name in bold and italics)

common French names (currently accepted name in bold and italics)

Mi'kmaq names (where attributed to a particular species)

Sub-specific names are provided if there is a genetic or geographic differentiation of populations noted in the literature. Synonyms in each category are listed alphabetically.

For cross-reference, the sources of synonyms in scientific names are provided following the name citation e.g.

It should be noted that in many early publications, the name (and/or date) given following the binomial name does not necessarily refer to the authority for the name but may refer to the citation of that specific name in an earlier work. These have been included in the format in which they are presented in the references cited. The current names are those noted in Page et al., (2013) with updates from ITIS, (2018) - accessed 3 October 2018).

Where the citation is noted as NSPM (Nova Scotia Provincial Museum), the respective catalogue numbers recorded in the Nova Scotia Accessions Ledger (1899-2018) for those specimens are provided.

Synonyms include both the primary nominal designation (genus and species) in the article as well as other names cited within each reference that have some Atlantic Canadian regional basis. If an author has produced revisions including additions or changes to listings in the earlier editions only the changes or additions included in the revision will be attributed to the newer citations in this document.

The variations in Mi'kmaw animal names recorded may reflect a synonymy somewhat parallel to that presented in the scientific and Western lay literature. However, they may also reflect differences in orthographies that may have arisen with the generation of a written form/language from earlier oral or pictographic forms. There may as well be a degree of regional variation within these orthographies. A more-comprehensive treatment of a broader range of Mi'kmaw animal orthographies is provided in Hebda (2014).

It is noted that in this review, several early sources have been used that nominally relate to New Brunswick, Prince Edward Island, Quebec, Newfoundland and the New England States. Due to the contiguity of these waters (for anadromous and catadromous species) as well as similarities in post-glacial dispersal and colonization by fish species, synonyms used in those documents for species recorded in Nova Scotia have been included. It should also be noted that many of the names included in fish nomenclature reflect a wider continental history so in some instances, articles of a broader geographic nature have been included if they provide reference to or offer additional insight into this fauna. This also includes cases where European appellations have been applied (either appropriately or in error).

This document may be updated as additional materials are encountered and readers are encouraged to share such publications to make this a current document.

Species of Fish from Fresh and Brackish Waters of Nova Scotia

Fifty-eight distinct species of fish are recorded as having occurred at some time in Nova Scotia fresh and brackish waters. Among these, some have been accidental introductions, others have been releases of captive animals (including pets), while others have been purposeful introductions for the enhancement of our fisheries. A list of these species (with accepted names) noted in this document is provided in Table 1.
